

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AN SUGGESTUONS

A. Conclusion

Based on the problems found in this study it was motivated by the fact that the Elementary School in the village of Parit Baru had not yet realized learning English as a subject for students, so students in the village of Parit Baru did not have experience learning English. Therefore, the English village program in Parit Baru Village was held in collaboration with IKIP PGRI Pontianak. Data collection techniques in this study used participant observation with instruments such as field notes and student texts. The translation of local songs is implemented through a genre-based approach and teaching procedures that include explicit scaffolding and guidance. As a result, the translation of local songs is able to improve speaking skills and simple vocabulary related to everyday life as evidenced by the development of competence and confidence in speaking skills. This is also able to foster the spirit of students so that they are not afraid and embarrassed when given exercises related to the material that has been delivered.

This study also explains that the classroom atmosphere becomes more fun and not boring because it can attract students' attention during the learning process. In addition, songs can be used as a medium for memorizing learning material. With the translation of local songs, this can be an alternative media that is easy to understand and apply in the learning process, especially English. Thus the translation of local songs is something that is needed in the learning process, because it can affect behavior, attitudes, feelings, and can increase student interest in learning. Thus, it is known that local song translations in this study can be used as a media of learning for English village students in making the learning atmosphere more enjoyable and better.

B. Suggestions

Based on the research results and conclusions that have been presented then the next researcher submits suggestions that may be provide

benefits to the parties concerned for the results this research. The suggestions that can be submitted are as follows:

1. For Head Man

The English Village Program has been implemented so that it can be continued in the future. In addition, the need for cooperation between the village and the village head to make this program run continuously in the future. Because with the English village program, children can learn English for free and can prepare their basic English knowledge to continue their education at a higher level.

2. For Students

Students are expected to participate in village program activities regularly once a week and follow the learning process well, namely by paying attention to explanations, taking notes if they don't know, and doing reviews so that this can improve students' speaking, reading and vocabulary skills.

3. Future Research

The results of this study are expected to be a reference and learning media so that they can continue to be developed and become a new innovation for further research in the same field.
