## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter provides the conclusion and suggestion regarding results research. The conclusions are drawn from the findings of the previous chapter, then the suggestion directs further researchers who are interested in conducting similar research.

## A. Conclusion

This research was conducted at SMA Negeri 01 Mempawah Hulu by knowing how students perceive English as an international language. There are two factors that become a reference for researchers in order to obtain data, namely internal and external factors. These two factors are further divided into fourteen aspects, namely; feelings, attitudes and personality, individuals, prejudices, desires or expectations, attention, learning processes, physical conditions, psychological disorders, values and needs and interests and motivation, family background, information obtained, knowledge and needs around, intensity, and size.

Based on the findings of the researchers in the field, students' perceptions were recorded in a positive direction. The researcher found that students wanted to master English well, because they thought that English was a cool language to speak. On the other hand, they also listened if the teacher delivered the material in English, they noted things that were considered important. In addition, respondents also said that they always bring an English dictionary and notes before starting the learning material.
