CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION & SUGGESTION

A. CONCLUSION

This study discussed School Closure During Pandemic; What Has Been Missing and also In what extent learning loss occurs in school as the impact of school closure. As explained in the discussion in chapter four, the main conclusion of this study is that learning loss actually occurs in students, and this learning loss occurs in all aspects, namely knowledge, skills and attitudes. Learning loss has a major impact on knowledge while skills and attitudes are closely related to knowledge so that skills and attitudes also experience learning loss. Turor conducted interviews to collect data obtained from students and teachers. The tutor got a good response so he got permission from the school to conduct the interview.

Regarding the problems that occur to students in the teaching and learning process, it was found that some students had difficulties in the learning process. One of the difficulties faced by students is understanding the material provided where students do not get an explanation from the teacher and have to learn independently from home. This shows that learning loss in students is clearly visible, so some teachers have to make strategies to guide students who have experienced learning loss, one of which is to provide additional assignments and more in-depth explanations by the teacher.

B. SUGGESTION

Based on the research results and conclusions, there were several suggestions as follows:

- 1. Principals and teachers must pay attention to the current backwardness of students which has a huge impact on the future of students.
- 2. Students are advised to be active in the learning process so that the interaction between teachers and students is not lost and is maintained
- 3. The results of this study can be used as a reference for further research in the same field.
