CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

From the results of research and discussion of student difficulties in writing thesis. From these data, the researcher found that all students experienced difficulties in writing their thesis. The researcher found that the factors that influence students' difficulties in writing thesis are personality factors, socio-cultural factors, and linguistic factors. Students experience difficulties in self-esteem such as in determining the topic of thesis writing and also difficulties in finding the right literature review. Then, students also experience difficulties in understanding university culture. It was about the difficulty in understanding the standard format for writing a thesis at university. The last one is about paraphrasing sentences from sources to writing their thesis. In addition, from three factors consisting of personality factors or internal factors and sociocultural, linguistic or external factors, the most difficult factor in thesis writing is personality or internal factors.

B. Suggestion
