CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

A. Research Background

Writing is an essential skill for students in the digital age, as it allows them to communicate and express their views and ideas from various perspectives. Writing is also a way to explore and develop one's thoughts through sentences and paragraphs, which can effectively convey language to readers with feelings and opinions. However, the reality of students' writing skills in learning English at school, as observed in the classroom and supported by evidence from assessments and student work samples from the teacher of SMA Negeri 2 Sungai Kakap, reveals that many students face challenges in developing their writing skills. Students often struggle with various difficulties, such as poor organization of ideas, lack of coherence and cohesion, limited vocabulary, and grammar errors. These challenges hinder students' ability to produce well-structured, coherent, and grammatically accurate written content in English, which can impact their academic performance and prospects.

The difficulties students deal in developing their writing skills may be attributed to several factors. According to Alfaki (2015), these factors may include students' low motivation, inadequate time, lack of opportunities for practice and teacher's feedback. It is important to focus on elaborating on the problems caused by students themselves, avoiding blaming teachers or ineffective teaching strategies/techniques.

To address these challenges, the proposed research suggests using Canva as a potential solution to improve students' writing skills. Canva, as a graphic design platform, offers a user-friendly interface, a wide range of design elements, and customizable templates that can be utilized to create visually appealing written content. Canva can provide students with an engaging and interactive writing experience that integrates visual design elements into their written work, promoting creativity, critical thinking, and effective communication. Previous research and experts in the field of language education have highlighted the benefits of using digital tools like Canva to enhance students' writing skills, including improved organization of ideas, visual literacy, and motivation.

Several studies in the past five years have explored the utilization of Canva in language teaching, showing promising results. For example, a study by Utami and Djamdjuri (2021) discovered that using Canva can improve students' ability and motivation especially in writing. Another study by Faqih, et al. (2023) showed that the utilization of Canva application enhanced students' writing significantly. These findings suggest the applicability and effectiveness of Canva as a technique to teach writing skills, supporting the need for further research in this area.

Therefore, based on the problem aforementioned above, the researcher was inspired to conduct action research because the researcher wanted to know whether using Canva could improve the writing skills of eleventh-grade students at SMA Negeri 2 Sungai Kakap in the academic year of 2022/2023.
