## ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were to implement the project-based learning method in the public speaking class and to find student responses to the implementation of project-based learning in the public speaking class for the second semester students of the English language education study program at IKIP PGRI Pontianak.

The study used qualitative research method specifically more directed at using the case study method. The second semester of the English Language Education Study Program IKIP PGRI Pontianak for the academic year 2022-2023 class A Morning involving 34 students as observation subjects and 10 students as interview subjects.
