

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter, the focus of this research is to analyze the difficulties faced by students and the factors that cause them.

1. Difficulties Faced by Students in Reading Comprehension

This research use open-ended questionnaires and interviews to analyze what the difficulties faced by students. From the result of research conducted, researcher found difficulty by students. These difficulty is caused by the many differences between mother tongue and English

2. Factors Causing the Students Difficulties in reading Comprehension

Based on the result of research, the researcher found 8 factors causing the students difficulties in reading comprehension. The causative factors are limited vocabulary knowledge, lack of fluency, lack of the familiarity with the subject matter, difficulty level of the text (reliability), inadequate use of effective reading strategies, weak verbal reasoning, problems with information processing, and problems in recalling information after reading. In some of these classifications there are several factors that greatly influence, making it very difficult for students to understand reading easily, namely vocabulary, grammar, and lack of understanding of the material to be studied.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusions from the results of this research, the researcher would like to give some suggestions for:

1. English Teacher

As an English teacher, it is advisable to interact more closely with students in order to understand and find out what difficulties students face when learning English. So, that in the future teachers can easily find

solutions to help students who experience these difficulties so that they can study comfortably according to the character or ability of each student in learning English.

2. Students

Students are advised to further improve their knowledge of vocabulary, pronunciation, and grammar. So that students can learn English easily and comfortably without any difficulties or factors that cause these difficulties.

3. Further Researchers

Future researchers are advised to try to do the same research with different samples, in order to find out whether there are similarities or differences in the difficulties faced by students and the causative factors that occur in other places.
