CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

Based on the result of the research and discussion that have been explained, in general it can be said that learning materials which was developed in ADDIE stages, namely analysis, design, development, Implementation, and Evaluation. The result of the formulation of the problem that have been determined are as follow:
